BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS)/CPR TRAINING

Training includes single and two rescue CPR for infant, child, and adult; AED (Automated External Defibrillator); how to handle a choking situation for a conscious and unconscious person; and use of AMBU bag.

Please note that if your certification is expired, you must attend the Instructor Led / Classroom Based training.

Class Size Minimum:	For the instructor led /classroom based class there is a minimum of 10 attendees and for the online/web based class there is a minimum of 8 attendees. If there are less than the minimum registered in a class, the class will be cancelled and the employee will be asked to reschedule.	
Cancellations:	All cancellations must be made <u>three</u> business days in advance of the class date or the department will be charged the class. Another employee can attend in place of the employee who is unable to attend.	
No Show/Class Tardiness: If an employee is scheduled and does not show up for a class, the department will be charged for the class. For the Instructor Led / Classroom Based classes, another employee can attend in place of the employee who is unable to attend. Please be prompt for the class.
